>>> This Month's FAAS Meeting: Our next general meeting will take place on Wednesday, October 8th at 7:00 PM at the Faith Lutheran Church Community Room (2012 Sullivan Trail, Easton, PA - Rear entrance). The presenter will be Mindy Hahn who will be discussing and demonstrating her many fabulous art skills. Please remember to bring your latest artwork for "Show and Tell". We will again have a free raffle for a piece of artwork open to all attendees.

Artist Biography/Statement: As more of a quiet individual who has always had difficulty expressing verbally, I feel that visual creations are closer to my true voice and way of connecting. Primarily the artwork is developed from traditional drawing mediums: pencil, ink, etc. combined into a mixed media piece. When paint is used, often it becomes more of a drawing material itself. The lines and shading are the words that create the sentences of figures and forms, and the whole picture establishes the plot. These sketched stories are an invitation into a world built from the details; the viewer is encouraged to craft their own experiences, interpretations, and narrative. The hope is that the imagery can start dialogs both internally and with others.

Presentation: It will be an art presentation to hopefully satisfy the interest of those present; I decided upon using a three-way approach. First will be a PowerPoint slideshow to share a brief introduction and history of my art and current focus (and share photos of some works I cannot bring in person), followed by a demonstration of how I create my pieces, and will end with answering any questions and time for viewing some of my art in person.
