**>>> This Month's FAAS Meeting:** Our next general meeting will take place on **Wednesday, March 11th at 7:00 PM** at the **Faith Lutheran Church Community Room** (2012 Sullivan Trail, Easton, PA - Rear entrance). The presenter will be **Kat Collins** who will be demonstrating how to create acrylic and mixed-media artwork. After having to postpone, Kat is feeling better and we look forward to her demonstration. Please remember to bring your latest artwork for "Show and Tell". **Presentation/Demonstration Description:** I will be sharing a talk and live demonstration titled “**Painting Emotional Weather: Intuitive Abstraction in Acrylic + Mixed Media.**” My paintings begin with raw, gestural mark-making and evolve through layers of acrylic, ink, collage, and drawing. During the demo I’ll show how I build atmosphere and depth, how I follow intuition in the moment, and how a painting shifts from chaotic beginnings into a more resolved emotional landscape—capturing what it feels like to move through the world right now.

**Bio / Artist Statement:** Kat Collins is an intuitive abstract expressionist based in Easton, Pennsylvania. Her mixed-media paintings explore “emotional weather” and internal terrain—layered atmospheres that hold memory, movement, and the shifting energies of lived experience. Working with acrylic paint, collage, ink, and drawing materials, Collins builds surfaces through accumulation and revision, allowing each piece to evolve through tension, softness, and transformation. Her work invites viewers to move between distance and close looking, where subtle marks and embedded fragments reveal themselves over time.
