SET UP: 8:30 to 9:30 Show starts at 10:00 must be set up and ready by 9:45

SHOW FEE: Non members \$45 for 10 X 10 space
\$35 for members (paid through 2025) for 10 X 10 space

- These spaces are limited

Non members \$40. for a 5 X 7 space
\$30. for members (paid through 2025) for 5 X 7 space

- All items must be hand made, NO store bought crafts.
- Applications are filled on a first-come bases
- FAAS committee will assign booth location. This is an outdoor event and is rain or shine. There is cover but vendors should be prepared for inclimate weather.
 - Vendors are responsible for providing tables, chairs and any other items
 - needed.

Registration Deadline:

Applications will be accepted through May 21th. You will receive and email confirming your space by end of May. Any applications received after deadline will be put on waiting list if no spots are available. Spots fill up fast so please send application in ASAP

CHECK IN: at the Registration table starting at 8:30am where you'll be assigned your space.

As a participating artist, craftsman, or vendor Please Read the following Rules and Regulations Carefully:

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. You must check in at the registration table and confirm your space upon arrival.
2. Set-up and take down: Set up no earlier than 8:30am must be set up and ready to sell by 9:45. You can start to breakdown NO EARLIER than 3:45. This is very important. Breaking down early hurts all vendors that paid to be part of this event.
3. By signing and submitting this application, You agree to release and hold harmless to FAAS and its board staff, Forks Township, related agencies and persons from responsibility for all personal damage to material, equipment, person, lost property or stolen. All booths must be manned for the duration of the event.
4. You're responsible for cleaning up your area at completion of event.
5. All artists, craftsmen, vendors accept responsibility for submitting all taxes due to the city, state, and/or federal government.
6. After unloading you must immediately move your car to the designated area.
7. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. This includes foul language and harassing other individuals. If you or any member of your team are found acting inappropriately you will be removed from the event without refund and will not be invited to any events in the future.

8. No alcoholic beverages allow on the grounds.
9. You are responsible for hauling your items to and from your space.
There will be members there to help if you need them.
10. Any Grease or Hazardous substances will be the responsibility
of the vendor to take away with them for proper disposal.
