


It looks like the Winter has hopefully come to pass and Spring is now "springing". Here is the latest news from the Forks Area Art Society.



The Forks Area Art Society is celebrating its 14th anniversary this month!!!


We want to thank everyone who has supported our group over the years in providing fun and exciting events and activities and in helping our local artists and the region's art communities grow and prosper.

My paintings mainly feature different lifestyles of the African people in the village, for example, "The Glorious Village Life". Division of labor (for accountability) with pragmatic (practical) learning (seeing and doing). Village life ensures protection of villages. It ensures a conservation of environment as you use it (thick thicket in the background). Responsibility has no age limit; there is work for everyone. The Village has all provisions. There is milk, firewood, eggs, chickens, and meat. Village life was a robust life (bright colors). Mom taught us to stand on our own and no matter how hopeless you may feel, never give up.
